



What is the SEA?

The SEA (Socialist Educational Association) is the only educational organisation affiliated to the Labour Party. We believe that Labour education policy should be based on the core values of equality, democracy and cooperation. SEA membership is open to all members of the Labour Party and supporters who are not members of other political parties. If you have ideas about how Labour could develop its education policy and achieve its aim of establishing an NES (National Education Service), we need you to join the SEA.

What impact has the SEA had on Labour?

The education policies adopted in the 2019 Labour Party manifesto were encouraged by lobbying from the SEA. A motion moved by the SEA and passed unanimously at Conference 2019 asks Labour to commit to bringing all schools and central services back into Local Authorities. The SEA working with academic and legal experts has also developed a strategy for achieving an accountable school system which could be put into effect from Day 1 of a Labour government. The Labour Party is now the natural home for those who want to see an end to the deregulation, privatisation and underfunding of our public services.

What is the SEA planning next?

The SEA wants to see the establishment of more radical education policy. SEA members continue to work with the Labour leadership to develop well thought out education policies that will lead to real change. We are currently running a series of well-attended seminars *Education Reimagined* in which we are considering alternatives to the curriculum, pedagogy and assessment approaches the right are currently pushing on our schools and classrooms.
